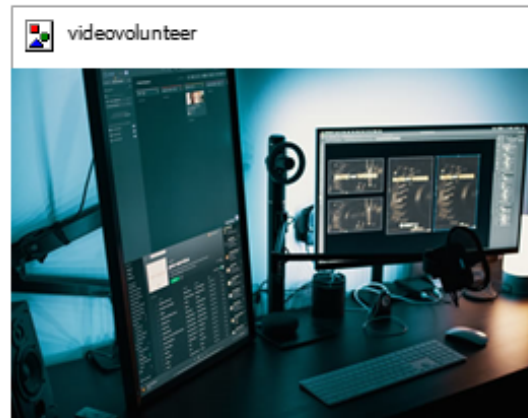
## Seeking Volunteers for Sound/Video Production Team
