The FPCL Session met in Fellowship Hall on Tuesday, June 28, 2022. The following is a summary of that meeting:

### Reports Given:

- The following were received into membership after meeting with subgroups of session May 21 or 22: Vinny Carbonaro, Matteo Richard Musso, Abigail Rose Reynolds, Marco Theodore Wilde, Julie Baer, Joey Baer, and Robyn Anne (Shreckengaust) Lakamsani. The baptism of Abigail Rose Reynolds on May 22, 2022 in the 10:00 worship service was also approved.
- The Rev. Christina Graham Voissem met with a subgroup of session along with Brie MacLaren and Pastor Wilde on June 1st. After that meeting, the covenant with the Rev. Voissem to serve as Parish Associate was extended, and she started in that role on June 16th.
- Room D1 (behind the chapel) is now part of the Smart Start Creative Learning Center use area, and room F2 (in the courtyard near the door) is now general use.

### Motions Passed:

- to formally appoint Jane Nebo and Jim Koch as FPCL representatives to serve on the board of directors of Interfaith Housing, Inc.
- to use undesignated Commemorative monies not to exceed \$5,000 to purchase two new AED (Automated External Defibrillator) machines to replace the two currently onsite.
