## What is "Per Capita?"

---

Per Capita is a Latin phrase that means "for each head." It is a term used to refer to an annual fee that our congregation pays to different levels of our denomination, which is the Presbyterian Church (USA). This fee is based on the number of active members at FPCL. **For 2023, our per capita amount is \$39 per person or \$78 per couple.** We are encouraging members to make an additional contribution to FPCL to defray this \$17,589 expense in our budget. To facilitate this, you can give a check with "per capita" written in the memo line and return it in the weekly offering or give online through the website and include "per capita" in the 'Add Special Instructions to FPCL'. Receiving a significant portion of this extra contribution would enable us to add additional support to the various FPCL ministries!
